

4.6.5 *Post Lamps:* With approval, exterior front post lamps may be installed on the side of the entrance walk as directed by the ARC, and 2' from both the front common sidewalk and the entrance walk. Only 3" diameter black round metal posts, with or without one symmetrical metal crosspiece, will be permitted. The crosspiece may not exceed 8" in length on either side, and may not be used for any sign or other decoration. The lantern shall match the design and size illustrated in Appendix A, with a frosted glass chimney and clear glass panes. Lamps may not exceed 100 watts.

4.6.6 *House Numbers:* House numbers shall be provided at each house entrance. Four black or brass numerals three (3) inches in height are permitted to identify a unit's street address. The numerals may be affixed to either:

- a) the wooden plaque to the right of the front door as originally positioned by the builder (the plaque must be painted the same color as the door trim or the window trim, and the numerals must be centered on the plaque);
- b) OR, if the wooden trim above the front door is at least six (6) inches in height, in the center of the wooden trim above the door, and the four numerals must be equally spaced over a length of seven and one-half (7½) to ten and one-half (10½) inches measured from the left edge of the first numeral to the right edge of the fourth numeral.

The numerals must be the same style as originally installed by the builder, or as approved by the Committee.

4.6.7 *Flags:* Only one flag may be displayed at any time. The flag may be either the United States flag, the Commonwealth of Virginia flag, or a decorative cloth flag and is permitted on the front or rear of any house. The flag shall be mounted on a wall-mounted staff, no higher than 10' above the entrance. Flags shall not exceed 42" by 60" in size, and shall not display offensive words or graphics. The ARC shall have the authority to determine if any displayed flag is offensive. Prior approval of the flag location is required.

4.6.8 *Decorative Ornamentation:* The addition of minor decorative ornamentation on the facade of any house is discouraged, but may be permitted only at the discretion of the ARC. Ornamentation must be compatible with the style of the house, incidental in size and appearance to the overall design of the facade, and not require modification of the existing facade for installation or attachment.

4.6.9 *Signs:* No signs are permitted on any house or property except for real estate, legal notice, or home security system signs as specified in the Covenants.
